NOTIFICATION FOR APPOINTMENT OF DIRECTOR

As directed by Chairman of the Search Committee, nominations are invited from reputed persons or institution in the field of law or legal profession for consideration for the post of Director, National Law Institute University, Bhopal.

Eligibility: A professor who has made significant contribution to knowledge and is an outstanding scholar in law with minimum of ten years of experience as Professor of Law in a University system or with at least ten years of experience in equivalent position in reputed research organization and adequate experience of university administration (relevant provisions of the Act and Regulations are annexed).

Selection Procedure: The Search Committee duly constituted as per provision of The Rashtriya Vidhi Sansthan Vishwavidyalaya Adhiniyam, 1997 (Madhya Pradesh Act no. 41 of 1997) shall consider the nominations sponsored by reputed persons or institutions in the field of law or legal profession and recommend a panel of names for appointment.

Interested persons of repute or institutions in the field of law or legal profession may nominate the name of outstanding scholars in law along with Curriculum Vitae of the person so sponsored with their recommendations for consideration. to by a majority of members of the Academic Council. The action so taken shall be intimated forthwith to all the members of the Academic Council. The papers shall be placed before the next meeting of the Academic Council for confirmation.

25. Finance committee

- (1) There shall be a Finance Committee consisting of the following, namely:
 - (i) the Director;
 - (ii) one member¹⁵ nominated by the Executive Council from amongst its members;
 - (iii) an officer each of the Finance Department and the Higher Education Department (not below the rank of Deputy Secretary) Government of Madhya Pradesh, to be nominated by the State Government;

 16(iii-a) one member to be nominated by the General Council;
- (2) The members of the Finance Committee shall hold office for a period of three years.
- (3) The Finance Committee shall have the following powers, duties and functions namely:
 - (i) to examine and scrutinise the annual budget of the Institute and to make recommendations on financial matters to the Executive Council;
 - (ii) to consider all proposals for new expenditure and to make recommendations to the Executive Council;
 - (iii) to consider the periodical statements of accounts and to review the finances of the Institute from time to time and to consider reappropriation statements and audit reports to make recommendations to the Executive Council;
 - (iv)to give its views and to make recommendations to the Executive Council on financial matter affecting the Institute either on its own initiative or on reference from the Executive Council or the Director.
- (4) The Finance Committee shall meet atleast once in six months. Three members of the Finance Committee shall form the quorum.
- (5) The Director shall preside over the meetings of the Finance Committee, and in his absence, the members present shall elect a person from amongst themselves to preside over the meeting.

26. Officers of the Institute

The following shall be the officers of the Institute, namely:

- (i) the Director,
- (ii) the Heads of the Departments;

(iii)the Registrar; and

(iv) such officers as may be prescribed by the Regulations.

27. Director

(1) The Director of the Institute shall be appointed by General Council in accordance with the Regulations made in that behalf:

Provided that the first Director shall be appointed by the Chairman of the General Council.

(2) The Director shall hold office for a term of five years, which shall be renewable by a resolution to that effect by the General Council. Upon the expiry of his term, he shall continue in office until his successor is appointed and enters upon his office;

(3) The Director shall:-

- (i) ensure that the provisions of this Act and the Regulations are duly observed;
- (ii) have all powers relating to the proper maintenance of discipline in the Institute.
- (4) If, in the opinion of the Director, any emergency has arisen, which requires that immediate action be taken he shall take such action as he deems necessary and shall report the same for confirmation in the next meeting of the authority which in the ordinary course would have dealt with the matter.

28. Head of the Department

- (1) There shall be a Head of the Department for each of the departments in the Institute;
- (2) The powers, functions, appointments and the conditions of service of the Heads of the Departments shall be as prescribed by the Regulations.

29. Registrar

- (1) The Registrar shall be a whole time officer of the Institute. The terms and conditions of service of the Registrar shall be such as may be prescribed by the Regulations;
- (2) The Registrar shall be the ex-officio Secretary of the Executive Council. Academic Council, the Finance Committee and the faculties, but shall not be deemed to be member of any of these authorities;

(3) The Registrar, shall:-

- (i) comply with all directions and orders of the Executive Council and the Director;
- (ii) be the custodian of the records, common seal and such other property of the Institute as the Executive Council shall commit to his charge;

CHAPTER-II

6. OFFICERS OF THE UNIVERSITY

In addition to the Officers of the University declared by S. 26 of the Act, the Finance Officer and Proctor shall also be Officers of the University.

(i) DIRECTOR: APPOINTMENT, POWERS, TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 1. Persons of the highest level of competence, integrity, morals and institutional commitment are to be appointed as the Director. The Director to be appointed should be a distinguished academician, with a minimum of ten years of experience as Professor of Law in a University system or ten years of experience in an equivalent position in a reputed research and / or academic administrative organization.
- 2. Subject to the provisions of S. 27 of the Act, the Director shall be appointed by the General Council on the recommendations of a Search Committee consisting of one person of eminence in legal education nominated by the Executive Council who is not connected with the University, one person nominated by the Chairman, University Grants Commission, New Delhi and one distinguished legal educationist nominated by the Chairman of the General Council, the Chief Justice of Madhya Pradesh. The Chief Justice of M.P. shall nominate the Chairman of the Search Committee.
- 3. The Committee after considering academic persons of great distinction in the field of legal education who could eminently fit into the post of Director, shall submit a panel of not less than three persons out of whom the Chairman, General Council shall choose one in consultation with the Visitor or his nominee as the case may be for approval by the General Council.
- 4. The Director shall be a whole-time salaried officer of the University.
- 5. The Director shall hold office for a term of five years from the date on which he enters upon his office. His term of office shall be renewable by a resolution to that effect by the General Council. Upon the expiry of his term, he shall continue in office until his successor is appointed and enters his office.
- **6.** If the office of the Director becomes vacant due to his death, resignation or otherwise or if he is unable to perform his duties owing to absence, illness or any other cause, the senior most Professor of Law shall discharge the duties of the Director until the Director appointed by the General Council assumes office.
- 7. The Director shall be the Ex-officio Chairman of the Executive Council, the Academic Council and the Finance Committee, and shall, in the absence of the Visitor and Chairman, preside at the Convocation held for conferring degrees. He shall be entitled to



be present at, and to address, any meeting of any authority or other body of the University. but shall not be entitled to vote there at unless he is a member of such authority or body.

- 8. It shall be the duty of the Director to see that the Act and the Regulations are duly observed, and he shall have all powers necessary to ensure such observance.
- 9. The Director shall have the power to convene or cause to be convened meetings of the General Council, the Executive Council, the Academic Council and the Finance Committee.
- 10. The terms and conditions of the service of the Director shall be such as are fixed by a resolution of the General Council from time to time.
- 11. The Director shall be entitled to free furnished residential accommodation at the Head Quarter of the University, and shall also be entitled to the transport and other office facilities at his residence.

(ii) REGISTRAR: APPOINTMENT, POWERS, TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 1. The Registrar shall be a whole-time salaried employee of the University and shall be appointed on the recommendation of a Selection Committee duly constituted for the purpose.
- 2. The emoluments and other terms and conditions of service of the Registrar shall be such as may be prescribed for the time being for Registrars of other Universities in the State of Madhya Pradesh.

Provided that notwithstanding his attaining the age of sixty-two years, he shall continue in office until his successor is appointed and enters upon office.

- 3. When the office of the Registrar is vacant or when the Registrar is, by reason of illness, absence or any other cause, unable to perform the duties of his office, the duties of the office shall be performed by such persons as the Director may appoint for the purpose.
 - The Registrar shall have power to take disciplinary action against such of the non-teaching employees of the University as may be specified in the orders of the Executive Council and to suspend them pending inquiry, to administer warning to them or to impose on them the penalty of censure or of the withholding of increment:
