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Mr. Manoj Tripathi, Chairman of BBMB has virtually appeared and explained that two officers of BBMB, namely, Shri Sanjeev Kumar, Director, Water Regulation, Lohand Control Room and Shri Rajesh Vashistha, Deputy Secretary (Administration), who were directed by him to release 200 cusecs of water per hour to State of Haryana, were restrained from doing so by the police personnel of Punjab Police. Shri Manoj Tripathi, Chairman of BBMB further informs that he was also obstructed (gheraod) not by the Punjab police but by some unidentified citizens of the area and that because of the presence of Punjab Police he could save himself. The aforesaid statement be made on an affidavit and filed by the Chairman of BBMB by tomorrow itself.

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It is pertinent to mention here that this Court while disposing of

this petition vide detailed order dated 06.05.2025 had recorded in paragraph-5

that there was some press release note (vide Annexure X), which was

produced by Mr. Jain, disclosing the fact of the meeting held on 22.04.2025

but no minutes of the meeting were produced. If a meeting was held under the

Chairmanship of the Home Secretary to the Government of India, then

obviously it has to be a formal meeting based on the request of any of the

dissenting State member and therefore, the Union of India is directed to

produce the minutes of the said meeting on the next date of hearing.

Mr. Jain, Additional Solicitor General of India is also directed to

inform this Court as to who is the competent authority under the Central

Government to deal with the matter under Explanation-II of Rule 7 of 1974

Rules when a representation is made by any dissenting State.
