			directions issued by this Court, two Personal Security
			Officers have been assigned for the protection of the
			person (whom we would designate as victim for the
			sake of the proceedings). The IG, Cyber Crimes has
			submitted a compliance report, wherein it is stated that
			03 primary posts have been identified, and that the
			said 03 posts have been re-tweeted multiple times, and
			are being widely shared; and that they are registered
			with Ticket Nos. LD-17194, LD-17197 & LD-17198; and
			that they have also identified 10 other objectionable
			comments; and that orders of this Court have also
			been forwarded to the social media platforms like
			Twitter/X, and that SSP STF, namely Navneet Singh &
			DySP Cyber, namely Ankush Mishra have also got in
			touch with the designated representatives of Twitter/X,
			and the contact number is also provided; the
			instructions to pull down the posts have also been
			conveyed through phone calls and WhatsApp; and that
			the representative has acknowledge the receipt of the
			notices, and has also informed that the matter has
			been escalated to the parent company in the USA for
			necessary compliance; and that the compliance from
			the end of the social media platforms is awaited. The

compliance report is taken on record. We hope that the social media platforms i.e. WhatsApp, Meta, Facebook, Twitter/X would abide by the directions, with the necessary urgency that the matter requires. The dignity of women, by itself, and in the context of our culture, is absolutely nonnegotiable. We hope that the spirit, with which this order is made, and the legal compulsions are considered in right earnest, and action initiated with speed. 5.
