

The present suit has filed for permanent injunction. Along with plaint I.A. No. 1 has been filed under order 39 Rule 1 and 2 r/w Section 151 of CPC by seeking exparte order of temporary injunction restraining the defendants and their henchmen from publishing, writing, speaking, broadcasting either in print media or in the electronic media or publishing or circulating in any manner or form any content/material which is defamatory about the plaintiff, his family members or associates or continuing to publish, write, speak, broad, either in print media or in electronic media or publish or circulate in any manner or form till disposal of the application.

After hearing the counsel for plaintiff and on perusal of affidavit enclosed to I.A. No. 1 and documents produced along with plaint, I am of the view at this stage, the plaintiff has made out a prima-facie case and case of urgency for grant an exparte temporary injunction against the defendants as prayed in the I.A. No. 1 and as otherwise the object of grant the injunction would be defeated by the delay. Hence, I am constrain to pass the following:

ORDER

Issue ex-parte order of temporary injunction restraining the defendants and their henchmen from publishing/further publishing, writing, speaking, broadcasting either in print media or in the electronic media or publishing or circulating in any manner or form any content/material which is defamatory about the plaintiff, his family members or associates or continuing to publish, write, speak, broad, either in print media or in electronic media or publish or circulate in any manner or form till next date of hearing.

The plaintiff shall comply order 39 Rule 3(a) of CPC.

After compliance of order 39 Rule 3(a) of CPC, the office is hereby directed to issue T.I order, suit summons and notice on IA No.1 to the defendants r/by 06/06/2023.
