Dear sir ,

Sub -Need to take immediate action the illegal detention of two innocent citizens in the incident of Judge Gayatri at Malur

This is to bring to your kind notice the serious incident of misconduct and abuse on a common citizen by a Judge at Malur namely Smt Gayatri.

The Judge and her husband are found threatening and abusing a young boy in an incident of road altercation and this video has gone viral on social media. On the very same day the boy was picked up and kept in the police station for no offence merely on the directions of the judge. 5 days thereafter due to the video getting viral the judge has gone to the police station in the night and got an fir filed on the boy and his grandfather (who had nothing to do with the incident). They were picked up in the late night by a police jeep and were Brought by the police to the police station at 10-00 pm in the night. We wonder whether ordinary citizens can be picked up

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like that and kept in jail for utterly simple cases lodged against them. This is really a case of gross misconduct and dereliction of duty by the police officials which cannot be accepted. Merely because a Judge dictated the action to be taken the police cannot be guided by her.

When the boy Vinay and his grandfather were taken to the station by the police the Judge was sitting in her car outside the station. They were taken into the police station and kept there until next day evening 6-00 pm. From 10-00 pm in the night to next day 6-00 pm they were kept in the station with the same clothes - this shows and is a glaring example of how our system treats a common man. A FIR was lodged at 1- 00 am in the night at the instance of the Judge for bail able offences.

All this has happened at the instance of the Judge who has wielded her influence and abused her power and put innocent citizens into the police station. This would not have happened if the police had exercised their powers in a proper manner as prescribed by the law. They have been partisan and influenced by the judge s directions and in order to please her this has been done.

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Also in the police station on confinement the police have taken a video recording of Vinay the boy involved where he had been directed to state that the Judge is not to be blamed as per the video. In the video which has gone viral on social media the Judge and her husband are seen heaping unparliamentary abuses on the boy and calling the police constantly to the scene until a constable arrives (who is mostly the court constable). They have got the boy slapped in open public by the police constable when he was pleading an apology.

This incident has received the attention of the entire state and general public are shocked that a Judge and her husband would behave in such a cheap manner. It has also shocked the people that police are behaving like her employees.

This incident will impact the faith the people have on the police force . The advocate fraternity in Bangalore and Karnataka and public expected that some action would have been taken by now but nothing has been done till date.

We request and demand that action be taken immediately to suspend the police officers involved as the situation demands stern and quick action to ensure that such instances of abuse of power amongst Judges and police are immediately dealt with.

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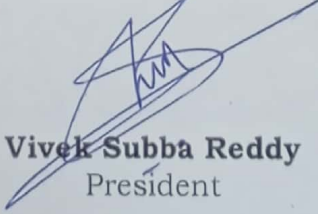

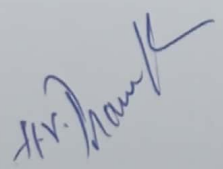
1. Acting on the directions of the husband of the judge and the judge's directions.
2. For detaining two ordinary citizens one the boy and the other his grandfather of over 70 yrs from 10 pm to next day 6 pm with the same clothes at Malur police station.
3. For forcibly arresting and detaining two people on the directions of the judge.
4. For the police constable in the viral video slapping the boy when he was seeking apology to the Judge without any provocation of any sort.
5. For having forcibly taken a video from the boy saying that the Judge did no wrong.

Our democratic system works on accountability and if this is taken away such incidents will occur.

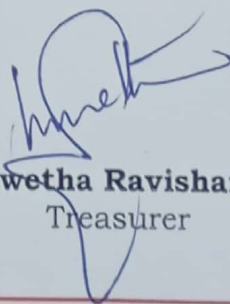
Therefore we request that immediate action be taken against the police officials responsible for the above acts by suspending them forthwith and starting an enquiry
