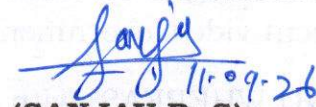

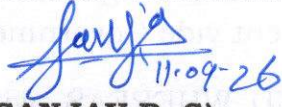

AND WHEREAS, with respect to Crime No. 188/2022 of Ramamurthy Nagar Police Station, a Show Cause Notice under the provisions of rule 8(4) of AIS (Discipline & Appeals) Rules, 1969 along with Article of Charges was issued to Sri. Amrit Paul, IPS (KN: 1995) vide notice read Sl.No (3) above.

AND WHEREAS, Sri. Amrit Paul, IPS submitted his written statement of defence dated:06.08.2026, wherein, the officer has denied all the charges levelled against him in the articles of charge.

NOW THEREFORE, upon examination of the defence statement of the officer, the disciplinary authority has decided to hold inquiry into the charges not admitted by the Charged Officer under the provisions of

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rule 8(6)(a) of All India Service (Discipline and Appeal) Rules, 1969 by appointing an inquiry authority and as well as a Presenting Officer to present the case in support of the articles of charges before the Inquiry Authority.

Hence, the following order.

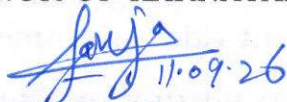
