3. Mr. Khan also accepts notice on behalf of respondent no.3/Hamdard Institute of Legal Studies and Research.
4. Ms. Priyam Mehta accepts notice on behalf of respondent no.2/BCI.
5. Likewise, counsel for respondent no.4/UGC accepts notice.
6. Counter-affidavit will be filed within three weeks from today.

7. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed before the next date of hearing.
8. Reotify the matter on 12.5.2020.
