The petitioner has projected this as a Public Interest Litigation and is seeking directions in view of the ensuing Bakri Eid. The apprehension sounded is that there will be slaughtering of animals in violation of the prescriptions of laws. As of now, the Bakri Eid is in this weekend, as we are told.

That being so, we would, for the time being, record the submission of the learned Advocate General that the State Government will strictly abide by the directions issued by this

Court on 09-08-2019 in W.P.372 of 2019 which was a writ petition making similar allegations before the Bakri Eid of the last year. We direct that the State Government and the local self-government institutions shall abide by the directions contained in the said order of this Court issued on 09th August, 2019 in W.P.372 of 2019.

Subject to this, we do not see that any further directions are necessary to be issued in this writ petition. Hence, this writ petition is closed and ordered accordingly.
