O R D E R

Application for permission to file special leave petitions is allowed.

Heard Mr. Shyam Divan, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioners and Mr. R. Basant, learned senior counsel appearing for the State.

These special leave petitions have been filed challenging three interlocutory orders dated 21.07.2020, 17.08.2020 and 18.08.2020. With regard to orders dated 21.07.2020 and 17.08.2020, we are of the view that no interference is called for by this Court in these special leave petitions. In so far as order dated 18.08.2020 is concerned, we grant liberty to the petitioners to make an application before the High Court for recall/modification of the order dated 18.08.2020. Until orders are passed on such application of petitioner, the order dated 18.08.2020 shall not be given effect to; and the same is ordered to be kept in abeyance. We, however, are of the view that looking to the issues, which are involved in the writ petition, the High Court may decide all issues at an early date.

Subject to above, the special leave petitions are disposed of.
