The two grounds raised in the petition have been recognized in the opening paragraph of the previous order of August 25, 2021.

2. Such order also noticed that a petition was pending before the Delhi High Court.

3. It is submitted on behalf of the Union that pursuant to an order passed by the Delhi High Court, the Union has now accepted that while conducting an environmental impact assessment study, the questionnaire will be prepared in the local language. The Union seeks some time for the guidelines or notification in such regard to be issued.

5. It will be open to the Union to address such aspect of the matter also.

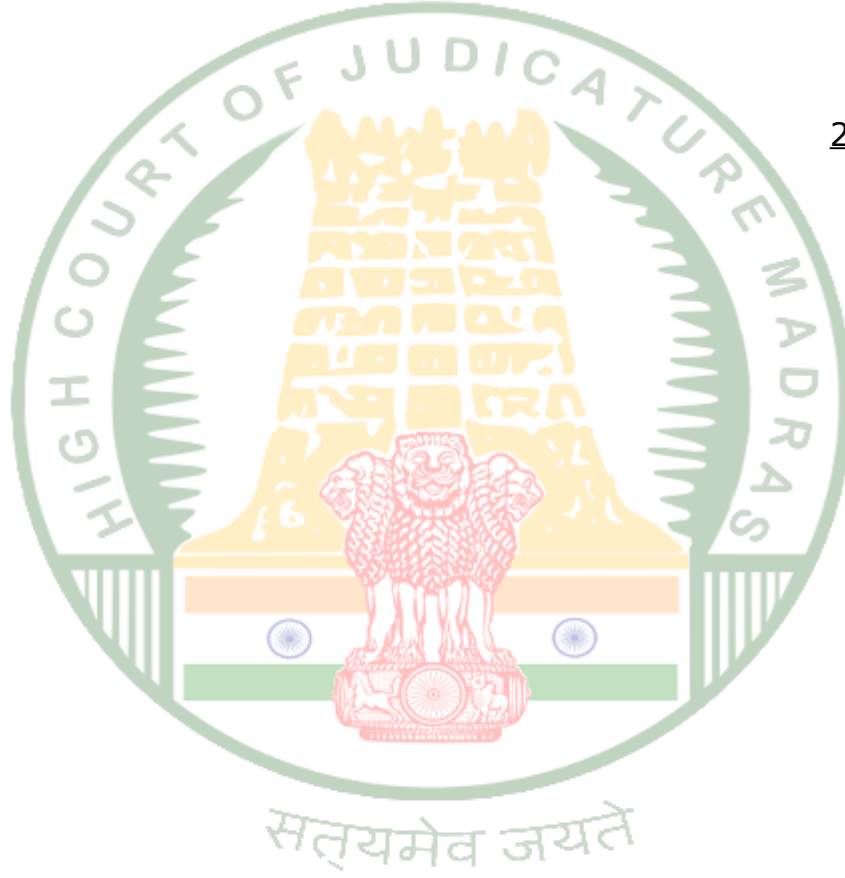
