ABOUT THE INTERNSHIP

This internship will revolve around one month, during the course of which students will be required to research upon nuances of Intellectual property law and other related fields in this realm. The students will be allotted one domain from IPR, as per their interest, which can be:

1. Trademark & GI
2. Copyright
3. Patent
4. Trade Secrets & Undisclosed Information
5. Artificial Intelligence

Interns will be required to prepare 2 research articles on topics that will be assigned to them before the commencement of their internship and prepare a case summary. The nature of the articles will need to abridge the socio-legal aspect of IPR.

After the concerned student has been shortlisted for the interview, he/she is required to appear before the interview panel with a total of 3 topics on which he is interested in research. The interview panel will then deliberate upon whether or not the selected topics are suitable for the internship. If found suitable the intern will be required to continue with it otherwise he will be assigned a set of new topics during the course of the interview itself.

P.S.: All the 3 topics submitted by students should belong to only one single domain out of the aforementioned five domains of Intellectual Property Law. Students will not be allowed to choose topics that belong to different domains.

PARTICULARS OF INTERNSHIP

- During the course of the Internship, the interns will be required to prepare 2 well-researched articles and 1 case law summary on the topics and case laws assigned to them by the Center. Submission of the assigned work has to be made within the specified deadlines. Delay in the submission of assigned work will be taken note of.
- The article should be an original work of the author and not under consideration for publication in any other journal or blog. The work should not be plagiarised. Submission guidelines for case summary shall be provided after the commencement of the internship.
- The article to be prepared by interns will ideally belong in the range of 1000 to 1200 words. All submissions must be in Times New Roman, font size 12, and with line spacing 1.5.
- No co-authorship is allowed.
- All relevant sources shall be hyperlinked as far as possible. If the concerned source cannot be hyperlinked, only then will the intern be allowed to cite it as an endnote (no footnote).
- The editorial board reserves the right to reject the submitted work of the Intern if it finds that the assigned work has been significantly plagiarized or is not up to the mark.
- Once the article/case summary is published on CSRIPR Blog the same shall only be re-posted with due credits to CSRIPR Blog.
- CSRIPR follows the three-strike system. In case of dereliction of duty by interns, necessary written or oral notice of warning will be issued to the concerned intern. After the third instance of such dereliction of duty by the said intern, CSRIPR reserves the right to take appropriate action against the intern.
- In case of any dispute arises during the course of the internship, the dispute shall be raised to the CSRIPR Head & the Center reserves the right to persuade & provide justice. The decision of the center shall stand final on the parties.
