ABOUT THE SPEAKER

Dr. Arvind Elangovan is an assistant professor of History at Wright State University, Ohio. He has extensively worked in the field of political and constitutional histories of South Asia. Dr. Elangovan writes about the framing of the Indian Constitution, its History and Politics, his first book being Norms and Politics: Sir Benegal Narsing Rau in the Making of the Indian Constitution, 1935–50 (Oxford University Press, New Delhi). Since then, he has published his work in several renowned and diverse journals.

Recently he was awarded a research fellowship by the International Center for Advanced Studies, a program based in Germany and in India, to pursue a project where he aspires to examine the powerful role of religious minorities in India, who helped shape the country in the 20th century. He has made a conscious effort to write from a more subaltern perspective, a clear departure from the otherwise prevalent Nationalist and Imperialist point of view, making him and his work more sought for.
