Temple from compound of his Official Residence.**

Respected Sir,

The complainant named below most humbly begs to submit as under:

1. That complainant is member of High Court Bar, and as such making this complain.



2. That, he has come to know from reliable sources that Hon'ble Justice Shri Suresh Kumar Kait, has got demolished the old temple which was in the compound of his official residence, whereas it was there for long time, and it had remained there even when Muslim Chief Justice were occupying that residence. It is pertinent to mention that it is not his personal property, and he should not have done this.
3. That, taking inspiration from it, one of the advocate of High Court Bar moved a petition, for removing temples from all the Police Stations in Madhya Pradesh.
4. There is reason to believe that Hon'ble Justice Shri Suresh Kumar Kait is bias and may be ordering for removal of all the temples.

Prayer

In view of above you all are requested to kindly: -

1. enquire into the alleged incidence of destruction of temple form the official residence of Hon'ble Chief Justice of Madhya Pradesh High Court,
2. Hon'ble Chief Justice of India is requested to issue direction to Hon'ble Justice Shri Suresh Kumar Kait, to recuse himself from Public Interest Litigation, seeking removal of temples from the police stations.
3. Direct for enquiry into the alleged destruction of temple, and if any offence is made out, initiate Criminal Proceeding against Hon'ble Justice Shri Suresh Kumar Kait, or permit complainant to file Criminal Proceeding against Hon'ble Justice Shri Suresh Kumar Kait.
4. Take any other action deemed necessary, including transfer of Hon'ble Justice Shri Suresh Kumar Kait to any other High Court.


