CIRCULAR

An urgent meeting of Coordination Committee of All District Courts Bar Associations was held on 21st August, 2025 at 04:30 pm on the issue of notification dated 13.08.2025 issued by Lieutenant Governor of Delhi allowing the police stations of Delhi to be the designated places for recording of evidence of the police officials.

Coordination Committee gave a representation on 20.08.2025 to the Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor of Delhi, Hon'ble Home Minister of India, Hon'ble Minister of Law & Justice of India, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Delhi, Hon'ble Home Minister of Delhi, wherein strong objections were raised regarding the said notification. It was specifically pointed out that the same is in conflict of the circular dated 15.07.2024 issued by Home Secretary, Govt. of India.

Coordination Committee in its representation has requested the authorities to withdraw the said notification. It was also stated that non consideration of the request within 2 days will compel the District Court Bar Associations of Delhi to raise strict protest against the same.

Despite giving the representation, the notification has not been withdrawn by the authorities. Under such circumstances when there is severe resentment amongst the Legal fraternity against the arbitrarily and unlawful notification which is against the fundamental law and public at large, the Coordination Committee in today's meeting has unanimously decided that there shall be a complete abstain of work in all the District Courts of Delhi on 22nd & 23rd August, 2025. No advocate shall appear either in physical or through virtual mode before courts. All the advocates are requested to cooperate. If any advocate is found appearing before any court either physically or virtually, strict action shall be taken.

Coordination committee will convene its meeting on 23.08.2025 depending upon the prevailing circumstances and to decide further course of action.
