Subject: Request for Review of the Transfer Decision Pertaining to Hon'ble Ms. Justice Tara Vitasta Ganju.

Hon'ble Chief Justice,

With due respect and utmost regard to the august institution of the Supreme Court of India and the authority vested in the Hon'ble Collegium, we write to respectfully protest and request reconsideration of the transfer order of Hon'ble Ms. Justice Tara Vitasta Ganju of the Delhi High Court.

Hon'ble Ms. Justice Tara Vitasta Ganju has served the Bar for 30 years before elevation to the bench with an unblemished record. At the Bench, she has maintained an exceptional record in judicial performance, consistently delivering justice with unwavering dedication, integrity and fairness. Notably, the Hon'ble Judge has achieved one of the highest disposal rates, with approximately 90% of listed cases being effectively disposed of, a rare and commendable achievement that directly contributes to reducing pendency and enhancing the justice delivery system. Furthermore, the Hon'ble Judge has delivered judgements on diverse jurisprudences, be it commercial matters, rent revisions, labour matters, arbitration appeals, etc.

Due to the Hon'ble Judge's commitment and efficiency, even the Rent Revision Roster has been streamlined from two courts to now, one, showcasing how a single bench under the Judge's stewardship could handle an extensive caseload with remarkable effectiveness and high disposal rate.

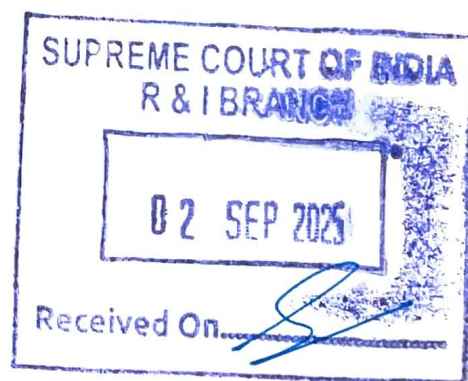
Beyond statistics, Hon'ble Ms. Justice Tara Vitasta Ganju has also demonstrated a strong commitment to mentoring and promoting young lawyers, often encouraging newly enrolled members of the bar in the courtroom. Moreover, the Judge's support for the advancement of women and young lawyers in the legal profession, is well-recognized and deeply appreciated.

In the above background, it is unfortunate and concerning that a judge who has contributed immensely to impart justice is being shunted rather than appreciated. The principles of judicial independence, merit-based advancement and recognition of judicial excellence should ideally be the guiding parameters in such crucial decisions. In this context, the proposed transfer appears unwarranted and detrimental to the institutional integrity of the Delhi High Court. It will certainly be perceived as a significant loss to the judiciary.

In view of the above, we humbly request that the transfer decision be reconsidered and reviewed by the Hon'ble Collegium, keeping in mind the larger interests of justice, judicial integrity, and public confidence in the fairness of judicial administration.
