THE HIGH COURT OF GUJARAT (DESIGNATION OF SENIOR ADVOCATES) RULES, 2025


In exercise of powers conferred by Article 227 of the Constitution of India read with Sections 34(1) and 16(2) of the Advocates Act, 1961 and in accordance with guidelines laid down by the Supreme Court of India in Judgment dated 13.05.2025 in Criminal Appeal No. 865 of 2025 in case of Jitender @ Kalla Vs. State (NCT of Delhi) and Anr., and in supersession of the previous rules, the High Court of Gujarat makes following rules for designation of an advocate as Senior Advocate and matters incidental thereto.

(1) Short title and commencement:

- (i) These Rules shall be called "The High Court of Gujarat (Designation of Senior Advocates) Rules, 2025".
- (ii) These Rules shall extend throughout the territorial jurisdiction of the High Court of Gujarat.
- (iii) These Rules shall come into force on and with effect from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

(2) Definitions:

- (a) "Advocate Act" means the 'Advocates Act, 1961';
- (b) "Advocates" means an Advocate who has been admitted to the rolls and continues to be on the rolls of the Bar Council of Gujarat constituted under Advocates Act, 1961;
- (c) "High Court" means the High Court of Gujarat at Ahmedabad;
- (d) "Chief Justice" means Chief Justice of High Court of Gujarat and includes a Judge appointed under the Constitution to perform the duties of Chief Justice;
- (e) "Full Court" means meeting of all the Hon'ble Judges of High Court convened by the Hon'ble Chief Justice;



- (f) "Secretariat" means the permanent Secretariat constituted by Hon'ble the Chief Justice;
- (g) "Judge" means Judge of the High Court of Gujarat;
- (h) "Registrar General" means Registrar General of the High Court of Gujarat;
- (i) "Registry" means the Registry of the High Court of Gujarat;
- (j) "Rules" means the Gujarat High Court Rules;
- (k) "State" means the State of Gujarat;
- (l) "State Bar Council" means the Bar Council of Gujarat and shall include the authority exercising such powers.

(3) Eligibility condition for designation of Senior Advocate:

- (a) An advocate shall be eligible to be designated as Senior Advocate, if he/she:
 - (i) has minimum standing of 20 years at the Bar ordinarily practicing in the High Court of Gujarat at Ahmedabad and/or before District Judiciary/Specialized Tribunal, preceding the date of consideration of his/her case for designation as a Senior Advocate;
 - (ii) At the time of making application for designation of senior advocate, the age of the applicant shall not be less than 45 years.
 - (iii) possesses ability, legal acumen, special knowledge or distinction and reputation achieved in practice of law.
 - (iv) has participated in pro bono work;
 - (v) has not been convicted by a competent court of law and should not have been punished for an offence involving moral turpitude or contempt of court or should not have been punished by the Bar Council of Gujarat or by the Bar Council of India for any act of misconduct.



(4) Procedure:

- (i) The process of designation of senior advocates shall be initiated at least once in a year.
- (ii) There shall be a permanent secretariat for designation of senior advocate which shall be constituted by the Chief Justice.
- (iii) In consultation with the Chief Justice, the secretariat shall initiate the process for designation of senior advocate.
- (iv) The notice inviting application shall be published on the official website of the High Court and its information will also be given to the High Court Bar Association/District Court Bar Association/Tribunal Bar Association for wide publicity.
- (v) Applicant will have to apply for designation in form as per Schedule I along with relevant documents and submit the same to the designated person in the secretariat.
- (vi) Desirous applicants will be granted two weeks time to make such applications which will be treated as their consent.
- (vii) Every application for designation as senior advocate should be endorsed by two designated senior advocates having standing of not less than 10 years as a senior advocate of the Gujarat High Court.
- (viii) The applicant practicing before the Hon'ble High Court is required to submit along with his/her application, 50 reported/unreported Judgments for the last five years wherein he/she has appeared as an advocate and has argued the case.
- (ix) In case of applicant, whose place of practice is other than High Court of Gujarat, then information regarding his/her suitability can be called for, from the respective Principal Judicial Officer/President of Tribunal before whom such applicant practices.
- (x) The Secretariat will publish the list of applications received by it on website of the High Court in order to invite suggestions/views of other stakeholders for the applicants.
- (xi) The Applications which are found to be in order shall be placed before the Full Court which shall be decided by the consensus or voting.



- (xii) In case of voting the decision shall be carried by majority of Judges present and voting. However, in case of a tie, the Chief Justice shall have casting/deciding vote.
- (xiii) The decision of the Full Court shall be final and binding.
- (xiv) The Full Court may, in deserving cases, confer designation Suo Moto, upon an Advocate fulfilling the eligibility criteria, after obtaining consent of the said Advocate.

(5) Undertaking:

- (i) An advocate who has been designated as "Senior Advocate" shall furnish an undertaking that he/she:
 - (a) will abide by the rules regulating the practice of Senior Advocate:
 - (b) will not draft or file pleadings in any Court and shall in all cases be assisted by another Advocate;
 - (c) shall not directly give consultation to any litigant and accept brief from the client;
 - (d) shall not file Vakalatnama or memo of appearance in any Court of Tribunal; however, the assisting advocate shall file memo of intimation in the concerned Court intimating the appearance of Senior Advocate in the case so engaged; and
 - (e) shall neither appear for mentioning for any matters before the Court nor should he/she appear for getting adjournments;
 - (f) shall mentor and maintain minimum 2 to 3 young lawyers with less than 3 years of experience;
 - (g) Will not accept instructions to draft pleadings/affidavits, advise on evidence or do any drafting or work of analogous nature in any court or tribunal, or undertake any conveyancing work of any kind whatsoever. However, this prohibition shall not extend to settling any such matter as aforesaid in consultation with instructing advocate.

(h) Shall not be a standing counsel of Government, public sector undertaking, institution or local corporate body and if he/she holds such position, he/she shall resign or relinquish the same upon being designated as senior advocate.

(6) Registration as Senior Advocate:

- (i) upon furnishing of an undertaking in a manner stated in rule-5, the name of advocate who has been designated as Senior Advocate, shall be entered in the register of Senior Advocates to be maintained by the Court. The order to this effect shall be issued conferring such distinction on advocate, by the Registrar General. The Advocate shall thereafter be addressed as "Senior Advocate" of the High Court;
- (ii) upon an advocate being designated as Senior Advocate, the Registrar General shall communicate the same to the Supreme Court of India and all the High Courts and Bar Council of India, the State Bar Councils and Bar Association of the State. The Registrar General shall notify the same on the official website of High Court also.

(7) Review and Recall:

- (a) If it is found that any Senior Advocate has -
 - (i) committed any professional misconduct;
 - (ii) shown intemperate or indecorous behaviour either inside or outside the Court or during the virtual hearing;
 - (iii) has been found invariably negligent in discharging his professional duties;
 - (iv) been found by Bar Council of India or Bar Council of Gujarat or Bar Council of any other State to have committed professional or other misconduct;
 - (v) been convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude or for contempt of the Court; and
 - (vi) for any other reason lost the privilege to be a Senior Advocate, for any one or more of the foregoing reasons.

- (b) The name of such Senior Advocate will be placed before the Chief Justice for recalling the designation;
- (c) On being satisfied that the matter should be further considered, the Chief Justice shall refer the issue to the Full Court;
- (d) If majority of Judges present in the meeting are of the view that Senior Advocate has forfeited his/her privilege, the Full Court shall recall his/her designation as Senior Advocate; however, in case of a tie, the Chief Justice has a casting/deciding vote;
- (e) The Registrar General shall notify the decision to the Advocate and to the Bar Council of Gujarat and other concerned who shall delete the name from the list of Senior Advocate maintained by them in their respective registers;
- (f) nothing contained in these rules shall prevent an Advocate, who has been designated by the High Court of Gujarat as a Senior Advocate, from submitting an application to withdraw or recall his/her designation as a Senior Advocate; In the event of such an application addressed to the permanent secretariat being submitted, the permanent secretariat shall place it before the Full Court for appropriate orders thereon;
- (g) The Registrar General shall notify the withdrawal of notification in official website of High Court while communicating the same to the concerned.

(8) Rights and Privileges of Senior Advocates:

- (a) The Senior Advocate shall have preferential right of audience in all courts according to his/her seniority as such advocate;
- (b) Senior Advocate shall be entitled to wear special robes mean for Senior Advocates;
- (c) Senior Advocate shall be entitled to other rights and privileges conferred by the practice of Senior Advocate under the Advocates Act, 1961;
- (9) Reconsideration: If an application of an Advocate for designation of Senior

Advocate is not favourably considered by Full Court, the said Advocate shall not be allowed to make fresh application for a period of 2 years from a date of such decision of a Full Court; however, after the lapse of 2 years the said Advocate can make a fresh application as per rules for re-consideration.

(10) Repeal and Saving: All previous rules, guidelines, criteria governing designation of an Advocate as a Senior Advocate made by the High Court of Gujarat with all amendments/modifications are hereby repealed; however, this shall not by itself, invalidate the actions taken under the superseded/repeal rules, guidelines, criteria and all those actions are saved under these rules.




