I.A. 27499/2025 (seeking vacation of ex parte interim injunction)

- This is an application filed by the defendant under Order XXXIX 1. Rule 4 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 ['CPC'], seeking vacation of the ex-parte interim injunction granted vide order dated 25.09.2025 in I.A. No. 24282/2025.
- 2. Issue notice.
- 3. Learned counsel for the non-applicants/plaintiffs accepts notice.
- Learned counsel for the applicant/defendant states that this application be treated as its reply to I.A. No. 24282/2025. He states that he has also filed





his written statement.
