Mr. Salil Sabhlok, learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, on advance notice, accepts notice on behalf of the State of Punjab.

These PILs have been filed primarily assailing action of the respondent authorities in cutting 251 trees in SAS Nagar Mohali.

The averments made in these petitions, *inter alia*, show that the tenders were issued for auction of right to cut 251 trees to make way for construction of Roundabout/Rotaries on various existing cross junctions at Sector 68/69/78/79, Sector 67/68/79/80 and Sohana Junction on PR-7 Road, SAS Nagar, Mohali.

It is further contended that as per information provided by Union

Minister of State for Environment, Forest and Climate Change, forest cover in

the State of Punjab is only 3.67 % of geographical area. Pertinently, the forest

cover in the State of Punjab is even less than forest cover existing in the State

of Rajasthan (4.87 % of geographical area).

In view of above, it appears that the functionaries of the State of

Punjab are neither serious nor they seem conscious of the impending

ecological catastrophe.

In view of above, inactivity of the respondents require drastic

remedial measures by this Court.

Accordingly, this Court prohibits the cutting of any tree of any

age/specie in the State of Punjab, without permission of this Court, till the next

date of hearing.

Mr. Salil Sabhlok, learned Senior Deputy Advocate General,

Punjab, is directed to inform the concerned authorities to immediately stop

cutting of trees in SAS Nagar Mohali or anywhere else in the State of Punjab.
