Having heard learned counsel for the parties, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount, each, to the satisfaction of learned Railway Judicial Magistrate, 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Jamshedpur in connection with Tatanagar Rail P.S. Case No.102 of 2025.
