Issue notice.

2. One factor, which has seriously made the Court concerned, is the fact that repeatedly, it has been noticing inexplicable and huge delay in trial being conducted, especially, by the State of Maharashtra.

3. In the present case, the FIR is of June, 2019 and still, in the trial, only one witness having been examined, speaks volumes of the conduct of the prosecution.

4. Accordingly, the Commissioner of Police, Nashik, shall file a personally affirmed affidavit, explaining in detail the circumstances under which the trial has not proceeded and also about the role of each of the accused persons with regard to the same.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that she will also file an affidavit showing how other accused persons, who have been released on bail, are similarly situated to the petitioner.
