

**RESOLUTION PASSED IN THE GENERAL HOUSE MEETING OF PUNJAB & HARYANA HIGH COURT BAR ASSOCIATION, CHANDIGARH HELD ON 19.03.2026**

Today, i.e. 19.03.2026, a General House Meeting of the Punjab and Haryana High Court Bar Association was convened to deliberate upon the agenda items placed before the House.

At the outset, the Honorary Secretary apprised the General House that, pursuant to the decision taken in the previous General House Meeting, names had been invited for constitution of the Election Committee, including appointment of its Chairman, Co-Chairman and Members. It was unanimously resolved that the above-named persons shall constitute the Election Committee and shall be vested with full authority and all necessary powers to take appropriate steps for the smooth and fair conduct of the elections of the Office Bearers of the Bar Association.

Thereafter, the agenda requisition received by the Association, duly signed by more than 100 members, was placed before the General House for consideration. The requisitionist, Sh. Navdeep Singh, Advocate, addressed the House and apprised the members regarding the matter under consideration. Thereafter, members of the House were invited to offer their valuable suggestions and views.

After detailed deliberations and thorough discussion, the General House unanimously passed the following resolutions:

1. That there shall be only one Bar Association in the High Court, namely the Punjab and Haryana High Court Bar Association, Chandigarh and no other Bar Association, including any Senior Advocates Association, shall be recognized.
2. That no Office Bearers, whether by election or otherwise, shall be elected or recognized except those of the Executive Committee of the Punjab and Haryana High Court Bar Association, Chandigarh. No office bearers of the Senior Advocates Association including the President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer etc. shall be recognized.
3. That only the Executive Committee of the Punjab and Haryana High Court Bar Association shall be entitled to represent the Bar Association in all official meetings, functions and affairs of the Punjab & Haryana High Court and/ or other authorities, and intimation in this regard would be sent to Hon'ble The Chief Justice, Punjab & Haryana High Court and the States of Punjab, Haryana and UT Chandigarh.
4. That the room presently referred to as the "Senior Advocates Association Lounge" shall henceforth be renamed as the "Senior Advocates Room".
5. That the inauguration plaque displaying the names of any Office Bearers other than the Office Bearers of the Punjab and Haryana High Court Bar Association shall be removed immediately.

The General House was concluded with a vote of thanks.
