JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of impugned notice/order dated 13.03.2026 whereby Haryana State Commission for Women has directed Superintendent of Police, Panipat to register an FIR and arrest him in connection with summons dated 06.03.2026.

2. The petitioner is a singer. FIR No. 28 dated 06.03.2026 has been registered against him at Police Station Cyber Crime, Panchkula alleging commission of offense punishable under Sections 3 and 4 of Indecent Representation of Women (Prohibition) Act 1986 and Section 296 of BNS, 2023. The aforesaid FIR has been registered on account of his song "Tateeree" circulated on online platforms including YouTube. He was issued summons dated 06.03.2026 by Haryana State Commission for Women to appear in connection with complaint against him. His legal

representative appeared before Commission and requested reasonable time for appearance. The State Commission by impugned order has ordered to register FIR against him.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from S.H.O., Cyber Cel, Panchkula, submits that Look Out Circular issued against the petitioner stands withdrawn. He, on instructions from Superintendent of Police, Panipat, further submits that the Police Authorities are not going to take any action on the basis of impugned order dated 13.03.2026 passed by Haryana State Commission for Women. The petitioner has already joined investigation at Panchkula.

4. Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the petition.

5. ***Disposed of*** as not pressed.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
