1. This Petition seeks leave under Clause XII of the Letters Patent, 1886.
2. Mr. Kohli, learned Counsel appears for the Petitioners and submits that the proposed Suit seeks declaration that the Anti-Suit injunction granted by the High Court of England & Wales is bad in law in addition to permanent injunction and other interim and ad-interim reliefs.
3. Mr. Kohli has pointed out that although the material part of cause of action as contained in paragraph 20 of the Plaint in the proposed Suit has arisen within the jurisdiction of this Court, however, part of cause of action as contained in paragraph 21 has arisen outside the jurisdiction of this Court and that with leave granted by this Court

under Clause XII of the Letters Patent, 1886, this Court would have jurisdiction to entertain, try and dispose of the Suit.

4. Mr. Kohli also relies upon paragraph 22 of the Plaint in the proposed Suit as well as paragraphs 17 to 19 in the Petition in support of his contentions.

5. Having heard the learned Counsel and having considered his submissions and also having perused paragraphs 20 to 22 of the Plaint in the proposed Suit as well as paragraphs 17 to 19 in the Petition, this Court is of the view that, for reasons as contained in the said paragraphs and as submitted by the learned Counsel, leave under Clause XII of the Letters Patent be granted and is hereby granted in terms of prayer Clause (a) of the Petition, which reads thus:

“(a) This Hon’ble Court may be pleased to grant Leave under Clause XII of the Letters Patent to enable the Petitioners to file and pursue the above Suit against the Respondents.”

6. The Petition accordingly stands allowed and disposed as above.
