Proceedings against accused Savitri already **abated** vide order **dated 19.01.2019**.

Vide my separate judgment of even date, both the accused have been found guilty and convicted as follows :

Accused **Rajendra Bharti** is found guilty and convicted of the offence of **criminal conspiracy punishable under S. 120B of IPC** read with Sec. 420/467/468/471 of IPC.

The accused **Raghuvir Sharan Prajapati** is found guilty and convicted of the following offences:

- i. forgery of *Ext. P5 to 7 and P11*, which are valuable securities, punishable **under section 467** read with 120B of IPC.
- ii. forgery of *Ext. P5 to 7 and P11*, for the purpose of cheating, punishable **under Section 468** read with 120B of IPC.
- iii. for **criminal conspiracy punishable under Section 120B** of IPC

read with Sections 420/467/468/471 of IPC. .

Since, the offence for which the conviction has been ordered is punishable with imprisonment upto life, both the accused are ordered to be taken into judicial custody till the order on sentence is pronounced.

Put up for arguments on sentence tomorrow I.e 02.04.2026 at 2.00 PM.

A copy of the digitally signed judgment be delivered to both the convicts free of cost, physically. A soft copy of judgment be also e-mailed to Ld. Prosecutor, Ld. Counsel for both the convicts.

File be put up on 02.04.2026 at 2.00 PM.
