Learned Counsel for the petitioner assails the order dated 18.05.2026 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Additional Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana, Health Department, whereby the petitioner has been placed under suspension with immediate effect and disciplinary proceedings under Rule 7 of the Haryana Civil Services (Punishment and Appeal) Rules, 2016 have been ordered to be initiated against the petitioner on the ground of poor performance in ensuring effective monitoring and implementation measures relating to improvement of sex ratio. It is contended that the aforesaid ground cannot form the basis for placing a Medical Officer under suspension. It is further argued that if proceedings under Rule 7 of the 2016 Rules are initiated merely on the basis of data, there is every likelihood of false implication and fabricated cases being registered under the PC & PNDT Act. She further submits that the impugned action of the respondents is arbitrary and has been taken with a pre-determined mind, without properly

considering the material available on record and the settled legal position governing the issue.

Notice of motion.

Since the State-official respondents were served with an advance copy of the petition, Ms. Mayuri Lakhanpal Kalia, DAG, Haryana, puts an appearance on their behalf and prays for time to file written statement.

The State may file a written statement seven days prior to the next date of hearing, with an advance copy supplied to the learned counsel for the opposite party.

On request, hearing of the case is deferred to 27.10.2026.

Till the next date of hearing, further proceedings pursuant to the suspension order dated 18.05.2026 against the petitioners shall remain stayed.

In light of the stay granted by this Court, petitioner in **CWP-17272-2026**-Mr. Satyapal @ Dr. Satpal Singh be permitted to join back at his original place of posting.
