**VC is not functioning today in Saket Courts due to technical fault.**

Present: Sh. Tarun Srivastava, Ld. APP for the State.  
Ld. Counsel for accused/applicant.

This is an application for bail filed on behalf of the accused Pooja Rajput.

It is submitted by the Ld. Counsel for accused that no other bail application of the accused is pending in any other Court. It is submitted by Ld. Counsel that the present accused is not the main perpetrator as per the story of the prosecution. No recovery has been effected from the present accused Pooja. It is submitted that the accused has spent considerable time in custody. It is further submitted that the accused is willing to abide by any conditions imposed by this court.

Bail application has been strongly opposed by the State. It is submitted that the accused is part of the conspiracy wherein cheating was effected by way of impersonation as ED officials. It is submitted that considering the seriousness of offence and the fact that two accused are yet to be traced out, the application may be dismissed.

Heard. Perused the record.

Admittedly, the accused Rekha is stated to be the main perpetrator behind the offence. The recovery effected from the house of the applicant pertains to the uniform/ID cards, allegedly belonging to the co-accused Prakash, whose arrest has already been secured. The investigation qua the accused Pooja is stated to be complete and she has spent considerable time in custody. The chargesheet has been already filed against the accused and this is the first bail application since filing of chargesheet.



Hence, no fruitful purpose shall be served by keeping the accused behind the bars. Considering the facts and circumstances of case and nature of the offence, accused is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bond for the sum of Rs.25,000/- with two sureties each in the like amount with condition that she shall not contact/visit the complainant/witnesses in any manner and desist from doing anything which may hamper the due process of law. The accused shall always keep her mobile phone switched on and provide the details of the mobile number being used by her to the IO/SHO and also informed about any change in such mobile number. The accused shall not leave the country without prior permission of this court. Bail bond not furnished.

**Bail application disposed of accordingly.**
