1. The applicant was granted interim protection by this Court *vide* order dated 14.05.2026. Pursuant thereto, Ms. Manjeet Arya, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, submits that although the applicant has joined the investigation, certain further documents are required from him. The Investigating Officer may furnish to the applicant, within a period of



two days from today, a list of such documents. Mr. Saurav Agrawal, learned counsel for the applicant, submits that any such documents, if in the possession of the applicant, shall be duly supplied to the Investigating Officer.

2. Mr. Agrawal has also filed certain additional documents by way of an affidavit dated 01.07.2026, which have been handed up in Court and are taken on record. He submits that one of the said documents, obtained by the applicant under the Right to Information Act, 2005, pertains to a request made by the Investigating Officer to his superior officer seeking permission to travel to Mumbai “*for the purpose of investigation (search and arrest of the accused)*” in connection with the subject FIR, being FIR No. 695/2025 dated 29.12.2025, registered at Police Station Subhash Place, District North-West, Delhi, under Sections 316(2)/318(4)/61(2)/3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 [“BNS”], and another FIR, being FIR No. 674/2025, registered at Police Station Subhash Place, District North-West, Delhi, under Sections 316(2)/318(4)/61(2)/3(5) of BNS.

3. According to Mr. Agrawal, the said request was submitted by the Investigating Officer, forwarded by the Station House Officer, and approved by the concerned Assistant Commissioner of Police on 08.05.2026, during the period when the applicant was granted interim protection by the learned Sessions Court. In these circumstances, the concerned Deputy Commissioner of Police is directed to inquire into the matter and file a report before this Court regarding the circumstances in which such request came to be made and approved, despite the above position. There are also apparent errors and discrepancies contained



therein, including relating to the destination for which permission was sought.

4. Mr. Manu Sharma, learned Senior Counsel for the complainant, submits that the complainant wishes to place certain additional documents on record. He is permitted to do so before the next date of hearing.
