General rules of citation- Harvard Bluebook 19th edition

1. Book References:

AUTHOR(S), BOOK TITLE, Page No., (Edition, Year of Publication)

E.g.: DR. M.K. BHANDARI, LAW RELATING TO INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS 211(1st ed., 2006)

2. Journal Article:

Author(s), *Article title*, Journal title, Page No. (Year Of Publication)

E.g.: Charles A. Reich, *The New Property*, 73 YALE L.J. 733, 737 (1964).

3. Newspaper Article

Author(s), *Article title*, NEWSPAPER TITLE, Date and year of publication, page no.

E.g.: Ari L. Goldman, *O'Connor Warns Politicians Risk Excommunication over Abortion*, N.Y.TIMES, June 15, 1990, at A1.

4. Shorter work in a collection by multiple authors:

Authors, *Article title*, TITLE OF THE BOOK, Page No., (Edition, Year of Publication)

E.g.: KayDeaux& Brenda Major, *A Social-Psychological Model of Gender*, in THEORETICAL PERSPECTIVES ON SEXUAL DIFFERENCE 89, 89 (Deborah L. Rhode ed., 1990).

5. Unpublished manuscript:

Author(s), Title page No., (Date and Year)(Unpublished manuscript)

E.g.: Anatoliy Bizhko, *Capitalism and Democracy* 25 (Feb. 29, 2000) (unpublished manuscript) (on file with author).

6. Cases

Title of the Case, Case Citation

E.g.: *Zaheer Khan v. Percept D' Mark (India) Pvt, Ltd* SCC(5) 545.

7. Internet documents:

Author(s), *Article title*, TITLE OF THE FORUM, (Date and Year of publication), URL

E.g.:ElizabethMcNichol& Iris J. Lav, *New Fiscal Year Brings No Relief From Unprecedented State Budget Problems*, CTR. ON BUDGET & POLICY PRIORITIES, 1(Sept.3, 2009),<http://www.cbpp.org/9-8-08sfp.pdf>.
