Regional Daily Weather Report

REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY: -

Thunderstorm reported at isolated places over Saurashtra -Kutch , North Konkan, Madhya Maharashtra and Marathwada. Rainfall occurred at most places over Konkan-Goa and Saurashtra-Kutch , at isolated places in Madhya Maharashtra , Marathwada and Gujarat region .

On Tuesday , Maximum temperatures markedly fell over Kutch and No large change elsewhere over the state. They were appreciably below normal over Kutch, below normal over Sauarshtra, above normal over South Konkan-Goa, Madhya Maharashtra and Marathwada and normal elsewhere over the region .

41.5 deg c recorded at Jalgaon was the highest maximum temperature over the region.

<u>REMARK:</u> No large change is maximum temperatures over Maharashtra region during next 4-5 days. Fall in maximum temperature by 2-4 Deg C over Gujarat region during next 4-5 days.

FISHERMEN WARNING FOR MAHARASHTRA-GOA COAST FOR NEXT 05 DAYS VALID FROM 14TH TO 18TH June 2023:

Warning for NorthMaharashtra coast: (upto 75km from the coast):

Squally wind speed with wind speed 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely along & off North Maharashtra coast on 14th & 15th June. Fishermen are advised not to venture along & off North Maharashtra coast during above mentioned period.

Warning for South Maharashtra-Goa coast : (upto 75km from the coast):

Squally wind speed with wind speed 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely along & off South Maharashtra-Goa coast on 14th June. Fishermen are advised not to venture along & off South Maharashtra-Goa coast during above mentioned period.

Warning for high sea and other coasts (beyond 75km from the coast):

Northeast Arabian Sea: Gale wind speed reaching 145-155 kmph gusting to 170 kmph prevailing over the region likely to decrease becoming 125-135 kmph gusting 150 kmph during 15th morning to evening. It would weaken gradually further more thereafter becoming squally wind speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph by 16th morning.

Eastcentral Arabian Sea: Gale wind speed reaching 60-70 kmph gusting to 80 kmph is prevailing and would become squally wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph from 15 th morning for subsequent 12 hours.

Adjoining Areas of westcentral & northwest Arabian Sea: Squally wind speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely to prevail on 14th June.

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Wind warning along & off Saurashtra & Kutch coasts (Kachchh, Devbhumi Dwarka, Porbandar, Jamnagar, Rajkot, Junagarh and Morbi districts) including Gulf of Kutch:

Gale wind speed reaching 65-75 kmph gusting to 85 kmph will prevail along & off Porbandar & Devbhoomi Dwarka district coasts from forenoon of today, the 14th June.

It would gradually increase becoming gale wind speed reaching 125-135 kmph gusting to 150 kmph during 15th forenoon to night along & off Kachchh, Devbhumi Dwarka, Porbandar, Jamnagar, Rajkot, Junagarh and Morbi districts. Thereafter, it would decrease gradually becoming 85-95 kmph gusting to 105 kmph over Kachchh and adjoining districts of Saurashtra & Kutch by 16th early morning and squally wind speed reaching 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph by 16th afternoon.

Squally wind speed reaching 55-65 kmph gusting to 75 kmph very likely to prevail along & off remaining districts of Saurashtra coast on 14th 15th June.

Sea condition

Sea condition will be phenomenal over northeast Arabian Sea till 15th evening and rough to very rough over adjoining eastcentral Arabian Sea during the same period.

Along & off Saurashtra& Kutch coasts:

Sea condition is likely to be very rough till 14th evening and high to phenomenal thereafter till 15th June evening and would improve thereafter.

Storm Surge Warning (Kutch, Devbhumi Dwarka, Porbandar, Jamnagarh and Morbi districts)

Storm surge of about 2 -3 m above the astronomical tide is likely to inundate the low lying areas of above districts during the time of landfall. The astronomical tides along these districts could be upto 3-6 meters in different places.

Damage expected over Kutch, Devbhumi Dwarka, Porbandar, Jamnagar, Morbi & Junagarh &

Rajkot districts of Gujarat on 15th June:

Total destruction of thatched houses/ extensive damage to kutcha houses. Some damage to Pucca houses.

Potential threat from flying objects.

Bending/uprooting of power and communication poles.

Major damage to Kutcha and Pucca roads. Flooding of escape routes. Disruption of railways, overhead power lines and signalling systems.

Widespread damage to standing crops, plantations, orchards, falling of green coconuts and tearing of palm fronds. Blowing down of bushy trees like mango.

Small boats, country crafts may get detached from moorings.

Visibility severely affected due to salt spray.

Fishermen Warning & Action Suggested (Kutch, Devbhumi Dwarka, Porbandar, Jamnagar, Rajkot, Junagarh and Morbi districts) and for Offshore & Onshore Industries (Graphics Attached):

Total suspension of fishing operations over eastcentral and adjoining Westcentral Arabian Sea till 15th June and over northeast Arabian Sea during 14th -15th June

Those out at sea are advised to return to coast.

Judicious regulation of offshore and onshore activities.

Ports along the west coast of India may take necessary precautions.

Naval base operations may maintain necessary precautions.

Movement in motor boats and small ships all & off these coasts to be avoided.

Mobilise evacuation from coastal areas of Saurashtra and Kutch (Kutch, Devbhumi Dwarka, Porbandar, Jamnagar, Rajkot, Junagarh and Morbi districts).

Judicious regulation of rail and road traffic.

People in affected areas to remain indoors.

Tourism activities may be restricted over these areas.

Preparatory actions before the cyclones.

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High wave warning from INCOIS:

Gujarat: High waves in the range of 3.5 - 7.5 meters are forecasted during 17:30 hours on 13-06-2023 to 23:30 hours of 14-06-2023 along the coast from Jakhau to Valsad.

Maharashtra: High waves in the range of 3.5 - 4.4 meters are predicted during 17:30 hours on 13-06-2023 to 23:30 hours of 14-06-2023 along the coast from Malvan to Vasai of Maharashtra coast.

Goa: High waves in the range of 3.0 - 3.8 meters are forecasted during 17:30 hours on 13-06-2023 to 23:30 hours of 14-06-2023 along the coast of Goa between Vengurla to Vasco.

Port warning for Maharashtra -Goa coast:

The Very Severe Cyclonic Storm "Biparjoy" (pronounced as "Biporjoy") over Northeast Arabian Sea moved slowly northwards with a speed of 3 kmph during past 6- hours and lay centered at 0830 hours IST of today, the 14 th June, 2023 over the same region near latitude 21.9°N and longitude 66.3°E, about 280 km west-southwest of Jakhau Port (Gujarat), 290 km west-southwest of Devbhumi Dwarka, 300 km west-southwest of Naliya, 350 km west-northwest of Porbandar, and 340 km south-southwest of Karachi (Pakistan).

It is very likely to move nearly northeastwards and cross Saurashtra & Kutch and adjoining Pakistan coasts between Mandvi (Gujarat) and Karachi (Pakistan) near Jakhau Port (Gujarat) by evening of 15th June as a very severe cyclonic storm with maximum sustained wind speed of 125-135 kmph gusting to 150 kmph.

Keep Hoisted DW -II (Distant Warning no.II) at all ports from Dahanu to Marmugoa of Maharashtra - Goa coast.

ARABIAN SEA INFERENCE:

The Very Severe Cyclonic Storm "Biparjoy" (pronounced as "Biporjoy") over Northeast Arabian Sea moved slowly northwards with a speed of 3 kmph during past 6- hours and lay centered at 0830 hours IST of today, the 14 th June, 2023 over the same region near latitude 21.9°N and longitude 66.3°E, about 280 km west-southwest of Jakhau Port (Gujarat), 290 km west-southwest of Devbhumi Dwarka, 300 km west-southwest of Naliya, 350 km west-northwest of Porbandar, and 340 km south-southwest of Karachi (Pakistan).

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The trough at mean sea level now lies over Southeast & adjoining Eastcentral Arabian Sea off south Maharashtra to Kerala coasts. South west Monsoon Strong to Vigorous Central Arabian sea to south of Lat 17 Deg N, Moderate to strong over South East Arabian sea, Moderate over South west Arabian sea.
