INSTRUCTIONS TO THE VOTERS

1. Voting shall take place in the High Court premises on 21st, 22nd and 23rd February, 2026 from 09.00 AM to 05.00 PM.
2. **No mobile/camera, smart watch or similar device shall be allowed** and there shall be a frisking at the Entry Gates by the Police, as is presently being done. Voters shall plan to keep their mobile phones or other gadgets in their own safe custody.
3. To cast your vote, Identity Card issued by the BCD shall be acceptable. In case, any voter is not having a BCD Identity Card, or Card has expired, he/she can produce a Card issued by any Bar Association of Delhi along with one of the Government ID, i.e. Aadhar Card, Passport, Election Voter Card and Driving Licence.
4. The entry and exit points for the Male Advocates enrolled up to year 2005 and all the Female Advocates have been designated from Gate No. 3 as Entry Gate and Gate No. 4 for Exit.
5. The entry and exit points for the Male Advocates enrolled from year 2006 onwards have been designated from Gate No. 7 as Entry Gate and Gate No. 5 for Exit.

6. No female Voter shall enter from Gate No. 7.
7. At both the ends of Sher Shah Suri Road on Mathura Road side and India Gate side, Wheelchairs will be made available for Physically Challenged/Needy Persons.
8. Sher Shah Suri Marg shall be fully blocked for vehicular traffic. The parking shall be available in the National Stadium from Gate No. 5A and the Zoo Parking shall also be available.
9. Buses shall ply from all the Five District Courts namely Rohini, Dwarka, Saket, Tis Hazari and Karkardooma Courts. Buses from Rohini, Tis Hazari and Karkardooma Courts Complex will drop the voters at Sher Shah Suri Road – Mathura Road T Point.
10. From Saket and Dwarka Courts Buses shall drop at the end of Sher Shah Suri Marg or India Gate side. Buses shall also be available from **Mandi House Metro Station**, via Supreme Court and **Supreme Court Metro Station**. The buses will drop voters at the end of Sher Shah Suri Marg on Mathura Roadside.
11. From both the ends of the Sher Shah Suri Marg, e-rickshaws shall be available for persons, who have difficulty in walking.

E-rickshaws shall also be available in the parking area of National Stadium to bring voters at the Gate No. 3 of National Stadium

12. Water facility has been provided by the Delhi Government at Entry Gate No. 7 and Entry Gate No. 3.
13. As per Model Code of Conduct (MCC), no outsider even interns/clerks (except the candidates and voters) will be allowed in the area around High Court of Delhi.
14. No voter is allowed to loiter or roam around, inside or near the polling premises.
15. No voter shall carry any campaign material, badges, pamphlets, or banners in the restricted area inside and outside High Court area.
16. After receipt of the Voter Slip, a Voter needs to immediately collect the Ballot Paper, cast the Vote and leave the voting area to avoid overcrowding.
