



AN INTRODUCTION TO CONSERVATION IN PRACTICE (IN MALAYALAM)

The Workshop is an intensive three-day program designed to empower individuals passionate about nature conservation, irrespective of their academic background, to become effective leaders in the field. This course covers a wide range of topics, including community engagement techniques, citizen science for biodiversity monitoring, communication skills with local communities, and conservation ethics. Participants will gain practical skills in engaging with communities, using citizen science tools for biodiversity monitoring, and communicating conservation messages effectively using different tools. They will also learn about the ethical considerations when working in remote landscapes and with vulnerable communities. At the end of this workshop, participants will be well-prepared to make meaningful contributions to conservation efforts while respecting local values and promoting ethical practices. Lastly, participants will have an opportunity to explore the surrounding biodiversity and learn basic biodiversity survey techniques.
