THE FIRST STEP - A LANTERN IN THE DARK

In 2012, Mustafa bought his first set of solar lanterns and sold them in villages where nights meant silence and darkness. For others, they were just small lights; for him, they were symbols of hope and dignity.

That spark grew into **KREPL Solar** — a company that now powers homes, institutions, and cities across J&K.
